Charges:

- Late kick-off, Art. 11(2)(h) DR
- Late kick-off (Mr. Murad Musaev), Art. 11(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine FC Krasnodar €15,000 for being responsible of the late kick-off.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.
- To suspend FC Krasnodar coach, Mr. Murad Musaev, for one (1) UEFA club competition match in which he would otherwise participate, for being responsible for the late kick-off. Said suspension is deferred for a probation period of one (1) year, starting from the date of the present decision.
- FC Krasnodar ensures that its coach is informed personally of this decision.

- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Charges:

- Minimum medical requirements:
  - pitch side medical equipment (Arts. 10.01, 10.02 and 10.03 Medical Regulations),
  - medical staff (Arts 12.01 and 12.01(b) Medical Regulations)
  - emergency medical room and equipment (Arts 13.01c, 13.01g, 13.01h, 13.01i, 13.01j, 13.01m, 13.01p and 13.01r Medical Regulations).
- Late kick-off, Art. 11(2)(h) DR
- Late kick-off (Mr. Mehmet Bülent Albayrak), Art. 11(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To warn Sivasspor Kulübü for failing to meet the minimum medical requirements.

- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

- GNK Dinamo ensures its head coach is personally informed of this decision.

- To warn FC Minsk for entering a player on a match sheet who was is not eligible to play and did not participate in the match.
- FC Minsk ensures the player is informed personally of this decision.

Charges:

- Minimum medical requirements, Art. 10.01 UEFA Medical Regulations (pitchside medical equipment, MD-1)

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To warn Futsal P. Kherson for failing to meet the minimum medical requirements.

- To warn the Lithuanian Football Federation for failing to meet the minimum medical requirements, i.e. for the missing suture materials.

- To warn the Football Association of Montenegro for the improper conduct of the team.

- To warn the Hungarian Football Federation for failing to comply with the match protocol, i.e. for failing to fly the competition flag.

Charges:

- Minimum medical requirements (pre-match medical information), Art. 14.01 Medical Regulations

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To warn the Portuguese Football Federation for failing to meet the minimum medical requirements.

## **2022 European Futsal Championship**

Competition: 2022 European Futsal Championship

Date: 8 December 2020

Match: **France** vs. Georgia (4:4)

### **France**

Charges:

- Improper conduct of the team, Art. 15(4) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine the French Football Federation €1,200 for the improper conduct of the Futsal team.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Date: 9 December 2020

Match: **Finland** vs. Serbia (5:5)

### **Finland**

Charges:

- Improper conduct of the team, Art. 15(4) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine the Football Association of Finland €1,500 for the improper conduct of the Futsal team.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.
