## **2020/21 UEFA Champions League**

Competition: 2020/21 UEFA Champions League

Date: 9 March 2021

Match: Juventus vs. **FC Porto** (3:2)

### **FC Porto**

Charges:

- Late kick-off, Art. 11(2)(h) DR
- Late kick-off (Mr. Sergio Paulo Marceneiro Da Conceição), Art. 11(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine FC Porto €45,000 for being responsible for the late kick-off.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.
- To close the proceedings opened against FC Porto coach, Mr. Sergio Paulo Marceneiro Da Conceição, for allegedly being responsible for the late kick-off.
- FC Porto ensures that its coach is personally informed of this decision.

## **2020/21 UEFA Women's Champions League**

Competition: 2020/21 UEFA Women's Champions League

Date: 4 March 2021

Match: **Olympique Lyonnais** vs. Brøndby IF (2:0)

### **Olympique Lyonnais**

Charges:

- Failure to ensure that the player selected for sample collection reports to the doping control station straight from the pitch as soon as the match is over, Appendix B, B(8) ADR
- Failure to immediately report to the doping control station as notified (Ms. Sarah Bouhaddi), Art. 21.10(a) ADR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Olympique Lyonnais €2,500 for its failure to ensure that the player selected for sample collection reports to the doping control station straight from the pitch as soon as the match is over.
- To fine Olympique Lyonnais player, Ms. Sarah Bouhaddi, €2,500 for her failure to immediately report to the doping control station as notified.
- The above fines in the total amount of €5,000 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.
- Olympique Lyonnais ensures that its player is personally informed of this decision.

## 2020/21 UEFA Futsal Champions League

Competition: 2020/21 UEFA Futsal Champions League

Date: 19 February 2021

Match: **Barça vs. ACCS Asnières Villeneuve 92** (2:1)

### **Barça**

Charges:

- Violation of the UEFA Return to Play Protocol, para. 14.2.4 (zoning access and movement on matchday)
- Violation of the Specific Operational Provisions and Guidelines Regarding UEFA Futsal Matches, para. 14.2.1 (match venue zones)

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine FC Barcelona €2,500 for the violations of the UEFA Return to Play Protocol and the Specific Operational Provisions and Guidelines Regarding UEFA Futsal Matches.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

### **Asnières Villeneuve 92**

Charges:

- Kit infringement (exceeding the number of sponsors advertising on playing attire), Art. 28.01 UEFA Equipment Regulations and Art. 45 UEFA Futsal Champions League Regulations

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To warn ACCS Asnières Villeneuve 92 for the kit infringement, i.e. for exceeding the number of sponsors advertising on playing attire.

## **Out of competition**

**Dmitri Aydov**

### **Dmitri Aydov**

Charges:

- Match-fixing (lack of cooperation), Art. 12(1) DR; Not abiding by the decisions of the Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body of 27 February 2020 and 11 May 2020, Art. 11(2)(e) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- The player, Mr. Dmitri Aydov, is banned from exercising any football-related activity until 23 March 2024, starting from the notification of the present decision, for his failure to fully cooperate with UEFA in its efforts to combat match-fixing and for not abiding by the decisions of the Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body of 27 February 2020 and 11 May 2020.
- To request FIFA to extend worldwide the above-mentioned ban.
- The Football Union of Russia ensures that the player is personally informed of this decision.

## Stefan Ristic

### **Stefan Ristic**

#### Charges:

- Attempting to engage in fraud (Mr. Stefan Ristic), Art. 11(1) & Art. 11(2)(a) DR

#### Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- The official Stefan Ristic is banned from exercising any football-related activity until 23 March 2024, starting from the notification of the present decision, for attempting to engage in fraud by creating and using a forged UEFA Pro License coaching diploma.
- To request FIFA to extend worldwide the above-mentioned ban.
