Match: Borussia Dortmund vs. **Sporting Clube de Portugal** (1:0)

Sporting Clube de Portugal

Charges:

- Crowd disturbances, Art. 16(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Sporting Clube de Portugal €10,000 for crowd disturbances.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Beşiktaş JK

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Beşiktaş JK €5,500 for throwing of objects.
- To fine Beşiktaş JK €17,000 for lighting of fireworks.
- The above fines in the total amount of €22,500 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Paris Saint-Germain €14,000 for blocking of public passageways.
- To fine Paris Saint-Germain €26,250 for lighting of fireworks.
- The above fines in the total amount of €40,250 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Charges:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Crowd disturbances, Art. 16(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To order Royal Antwerp FC to play its next UEFA club competition match as host club behind closed doors, for throwing of objects, lighting of fireworks, blocking of public passageways and crowd disturbances.

Match: **Olympique de Marseille** vs. **Galatasaray A.Ş.** (0:0)

Olympique de Marseille

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To order the partial closure of the Olympique de Marseille stadium (i.e. the "Virage Nord" sector behind the goal where the home club supporters are seated) during the next UEFA competition match in which Olympique de Marseille will play as host club, for lighting of fireworks and throwing of objects.
- To fine Olympique de Marseille €8,000 for blocking of public passageways.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Galatasaray A.Ş.

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Acts of damage, Art. 16(2)(f) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To ban Galatasaray A.Ş from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next two (2) UEFA competition matches and to fine Galatasaray A.Ş €50,000, for lighting of fireworks and throwing of objects.
- To fine Galatasaray A.Ş €8,000 for acts of damage.

- To order Galatasaray A.Ş to contact Olympique de Marseille within 30 days for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters, i.e. for the damaged seats and TV.
- The above fines in the total amount of €58,000 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Olympique Lyonnais

Charges:

- Invasion of the field of play, Art. 16(2)(a) DR
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Olympique Lyonnais €8,000 for the invasion of the field of play.
- To fine Olympique Lyonnais €16,000 for blocking of public passageways.
- The above fines in the total amount of €24,000 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Brøndby IF

Charges:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Brøndby IF €34,000 for lighting of fireworks.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine GNK Dinamo €11,000 for lighting of fireworks.
- To fine GNK Dinamo €20,250 for throwing of objects.
- The above fines in the total amount of €31,250 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Match: SK Sturm Graz vs. **PSV Eindhoven** (1:4)

PSV Eindhoven

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Acts of damage, Art. 16(2)(f) DR
- Crowd disturbances, Art. 16(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine PSV Eindhoven €13,625 for throwing of objects.
- To fine PSV Eindhoven €5,000 for acts of damage.
- To order PSV Eindhoven to contact SK Sturm Graz within 30 days for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters, i.e. for the damaged protective nets and toilets.
- To fine PSV Eindhoven €15,000 for crowd disturbances.
- The above fines in the total amount of €33,625 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Match: **West Ham United FC** vs. **SK Rapid Wien** (2:0)

West Ham United FC

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine West Ham United FC €60,000 for throwing of objects.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

SK Rapid Wien

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine SK Rapid Wien €60,000 and to ban SK Rapid Wien from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next one (1) UEFA competition match, for throwing of objects.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Match: **PFC CSKA-Sofia** vs. FK Bodø/Glimt (0:0)

PFC CSKA-Sofia

Charges:

- Racist behaviour, Art. 14(2) DR
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To order a partial closure of the stadium during the next UEFA competition match in which PFC CSKA-Sofia will play as the host club, for the racist behaviour of its supporters. The partial stadium closure shall comprehend at least 3,000 seats where the home team supporters are seated in the fan section, including sector G.
- To order PFC CSKA-Sofia to implement the following directive in the next UEFA competition match in which it will play as host club: to display a banner with the wording “#NoToRacism”, with the UEFA logo on it.
- To fine PFC CSKA-Sofia €8,000 for the blocking of public passageways.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Match: **CFR 1907 Cluj** vs. Randers FC (1:1)

CFR 1907 Cluj

Charges:

- Racist behaviour, Art. 14(2) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To order a partial stadium closure of the CFR 1907 Cluj stadium during the next UEFA club competition match in which CFR 1907 Cluj will play as host club, for the racist behaviour of its supporters. The partial stadium closure shall comprehend at least 3,000 seats where the home team supporters are seated in the fan section, including Sector 24.
- To order CFR 1907 Cluj to implement the following directive in the next UEFA club competition match in which it will play as host club: to display a banner with the wording “#NoToRacism”, with the UEFA logo on it.

Charges:

- Invasion of the field of play, Art. 16(2)(a) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine FK Partizan €8,250 for throwing of fireworks.
- To fine FK Partizan €10,000 for the invasion of the field of play.
- The above fines in the total amount of €18,250 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

Match: Feyenoord vs. SK Slavia Praha (2:1)

Feyenoord

Charges:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To fine Feyenoord €7,125 for throwing of objects.
- To fine Feyenoord €25,750 for lighting of fireworks.
- To fine Feyenoord €22,000 for blocking of public passageways.
- The above fines in the total amount of €54,875 must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.

2020 European Championship

Competition: 2020 European Championship

Date: 11 July 2021

Match: Italy vs. England (1:1)

England

Charges:

- Invasion of the field of play by its supporters, Art. 16(2)(a) DR
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of a firework, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
- Disturbances during the national anthems, Art. 16(2)(g) DR
- Lack of order or discipline inside or around the stadium, Art. 16(2)(h) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To order the English Football Association to play its next two (2) UEFA competition matches as host association behind closed doors, the second of which is suspended for a probationary period of two (2) years from the date of the present decision, for the lack of order and discipline inside and around the stadium.
- To fine the English Football Association €100,000 for the lack of order and discipline inside and around the stadium, for the invasion of the field of play, for throwing of objects and for the disturbances during the national anthems.
- The above fine must be paid within 90 days of communication of this decision.
- To close the disciplinary proceedings opened against the English Football Association for lighting a firework.

Match: France vs. **Ukraine** (5:0)

Ukraine

Charges:

- Rough play (Mr. Maksym Talovierov), Art. 15(1)(a)(ii) DR

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To suspend Ukrainian Association of Football player, Mr. Maksym Talovierov, for the next two (2) UEFA representative team competition matches for which he would be otherwise eligible, for rough play.
- The Ukrainian Association of Football ensures its player is personally informed of this decision.

2022 European Women's Under-17 Championship

Competition: 2022 European Women's Under-17 Championship

Date: 29 September 2021 / 2 October 2021 / 5 October 2021

Match: Netherlands vs. **Scotland** / Czech Republic vs. **Scotland** / **Scotland** vs. Slovenia

Scotland

Charges:

- Responsibility for the matches not taking place, Art. 29.01 WU17 Regulations

Decision:

The Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body has decided:

- To declare the 2022 UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship match between the Under-17 women's national teams of the Royal Netherlands Football Association and the Scottish Football Association, that was scheduled to be played on 29 September 2021, as forfeited by the Scottish Football Association Under-17 women's national team (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 3-0) for being responsible for the match not taking place (as provided for in Article 29.01 of the Regulations of the UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2021/22).
- To declare the 2022 UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship match between the Under-17 women's national teams of the Football Association of the Czech Republic and the Scottish Football Association, that was scheduled to be played on 2 October 2021, as forfeited by the Scottish Football Association Under-17 women's national team (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 3-0) for being responsible for the match not taking place (as provided for in Article 29.01 of the Regulations of the UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2021/22).
- To declare the 2022 UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship match between the Under-17 women's national teams of the Scottish Football Association and the Football Association of Slovenia, that was scheduled to be played on 5 October 2021, as forfeited by the Scottish Football Association Under-17 women's national team (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 0-3) for being responsible for the match not taking place (as provided for in Article 29.01 of the Regulations of the UEFA European Women's Under-17 Championship 2021/22).

Out of competition

Edgars Gauracs

Edgars Gauracs

Charges

- Integrity of matches and competitions (match-fixing), Articles 12(2)(a), (d) and (e) DR

Decision:

- FK Spartaks Jūrmala official, Mr. Edgars Gauracs, is banned from exercising any football-related activity for ten (10) years starting from the date of the present decision, for the violation of Articles 12(2)(a), (d) and (e) DR.
- To request FIFA to extend worldwide the above-mentioned ban.
- FK Spartaks Jūrmala ensures that Mr. Edgars Gauracs is personally informed of this decision.
