UEFA has a longstanding commitment to manage all its activities and events based on the core value of respect for human rights and environment. We have recently defined our commitments, and we wish to share the outcome with you. The attached documents outline UEFA's responsibilities and objectives in these two key areas, which have become increasingly important to football. Both commitments were established following guidelines from international institutions. They will serve as a basis for the development of policies, action plans and targets. The latter are defined through an extensive consultation with external and internal stakeholders.

This commitment is symbolised through the "Respect" logo, used:

- in blue for human rights policies, action plans and targets;
- in green for the environmental policies, action plans and targets.
