Dear Sir or Madam,

As part of the UEFA's commitment to guaranteeing the rights of individuals bound by the UEFA Disciplinary Regulations ("DR") who lack the financial means to properly defend themselves in disciplinary proceedings, at its meeting in Cardiff on 1 June 2017, the UEFA Executive Committee approved the concepts of legal aid and pro bono counsel as set out in Article 39 DR.

Following a thorough selection process, a list of qualified lawyers was appointed to serve as pro bono counsel in 2018 for a term of four years, with the aim to assist individuals in proceedings before the UEFA Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body and the UEFA Appeals Body.

As we are now close to the end of this term, we are now pleased to invite applications from appropriately qualified lawyers who wish to feature on this list.
