2020/21 UEFA fair play competition – final rankings

Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to inform you of the final UEFA fair play rankings for 2020/21, which are based on the fair play results obtained from all UEFA competition matches played at both club and national team level between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2021. These dates are defined in article 4.01 of the UEFA Fair Play Regulations.

Only associations that played a minimum of 25 matches have been taken into account. This cut-off point is obtained by dividing the total number of UEFA matches by the number of participating UEFA member associations.

As defined in paragraph 12.01 of the regulations, awards are presented to the highest-ranked associations in the following three categories:

- Overall fair play
- Improvement in overall fair play score from one season to the next
- Behaviour of spectators

Exceptionally however, considering the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020/21, which led to a significant number of UEFA matches being played behind closed doors, no awards will be granted for the "Behaviour of Spectators" and no crowd behaviour marks have been taken into account in the overall fair play and best progression rankings for 2020/21.

The winners in each of the remaining two categories will be awarded €50,000 to donate to amateur or professional clubs of their choice for fair play or respect-themed projects.

The results are as follows:

- Overall fair play: **Norway** with 8.44 points.
- Improvement in overall fair play score from one season to the next: **Slovenia**, progressing from 7.896 in 2019/20 to 8.178 points in 2020/21.

The winning associations are invited to send the name of their selected clubs, along with details of the project to which the prize money will be allocated, to delegate@uefa.ch. Following an assessment of the proposed projects, the prize money will be credited to the winning associations' accounts.
