Incident and decision:

- “Shadow coaching”, Art. 11 DR in conjunction with Articles 36(1) & (2) and Articles 40(1) & (2) UEFA Club Licensing & FFP Regulations
 - To ban Mr. Michael MacElwee from carrying out any function of a head coach, as well as of any coaching staff, at UEFA competition matches until he fulfills the criteria contemplated in Article 36 in conjunction with Article 40(1)(b) UEFA Club Licensing and Financial Fair Play Regulations. In particular, Mr. Michael MacElwee shall not seat in the technical area during UEFA competition matches until the above criteria are fulfilled.
 - Fine: €50,000
