UEFA Respect protocol flags

Dear Sir or Madam,

UEFA's Sustainability Strategy 2030 "Strength Through Unity" was approved at the last Executive Committee meeting, in December 2021. In it, UEFA indicates its advocacy for Respect for Human Rights and the Environment, portraying our actions with a blue respect logo for human rights and a green respect logo for the environment, as also described in our Circular Letter 80/2021.

At UEFA's events the Respect logo is present in several branded items, including the protocol flag. For operational reasons each competition will use only one of the Respect flags at each time. In the enclosure we indicate which flag should be used for each competition.

Please note that for club competitions, for the qualifying rounds / non-centralised stages, the National Association is supposed to lend the flags to the clubs. For the centralised stages, the flags are provided directly by UEFA to the clubs.
