### **UEFA Club Licensing Quality Standard (Edition 2022)**

Dear Sir or Madam,

The UEFA Executive Committee approved the enclosed 2022 UEFA Club Licensing Quality Standard in Vienna on 10 May.

The document comes into force on 1 June and replaces the 2012 Club Licensing Quality Standard.

These new regulations are the result of a complete and comprehensive review and consultation process, taking account of experience gained so far, the development of club licensing and club monitoring regulations and changes to the football landscape.

The UEFA Club Licensing Quality Standard consists of minimum requirements that licensors must comply with in order to operate the club licensing system as well as perform their responsibilities and duties in respect of the club monitoring process. The aims of the standard are to ensure a proper and efficient functioning of the club licensing system and club monitoring process based on the principles of consistency and equal treatment, and to further support better governance and quality management within the UEFA member associations.

The new 2022 Quality Standard, together with UEFA's club licensing regulations, ensures the independence and improves the transparency of decision-making procedures, and formalises internal control and risk assessment procedures among others. Stronger emphasis has been put on the proper implementation of the club monitoring process and on collaboration between UEFA and its member associations with regard to benchmarking. In addition, the new requirements define procedures to ensure the club licensing system and club monitoring process comply with national data protection regulations.
