Registration procedure for 2022/23 UEFA Futsal Champions League

Please find the following details about the registration procedure for clubs entering the 2022/23 UEFA Futsal Champions League.

Each association may enter the winner, and where applicable (see below), the runner-up of their 2021/22 top domestic futsal league.

The 2021/22 UEFA Futsal Champions League titleholder, Barça, is guaranteed a place, and its association, Spain, may consequently enter a second team.

With reference to article 3.03 of the 2022/23 UEFA Futsal Champions League regulations and based on the Men's national futsal team coefficient ranking (April 2021), the following four associations may enter the runners-up of their respective top domestic futsal leagues.

Following Circular letter N°21 send out on 2 May 2022, Russia will have no affiliated clubs participating in the UEFA Futsal Champions league 2022/23. This means that the association Croatia, ranked 5th may enter a second club in the 2022/23 season.

1. Entry documents

Please refer to the criteria and procedures set out in Article 3 and 4 of the competition regulations.

Each association must send the **official entry form** (enclosure 6 - one per club) to UEFA, by **Friday 10 June**.

Even if the domestic league has not yet finished and the champion not decided by this deadline, the entry form must still be submitted by **10 June**, indicating the date by which the champion will be known. Then, for such case, associations must resubmit the completed entry document with the club(s) name(s) by **Friday 24 June, 12:00 CET** at the latest.

2. Doping controls

Please refer to: Article 7 of the competition regulations and the 2021 UEFA Anti-Doping Regulations. Clubs are requested to take note of the UEFA pre-season anti-doping information and share it with their medical staff and the players concerned.

3. Medical requirements

All players registered for the 2022/23 UEFA Futsal Champions League must undergo a pre-competition medical examination. Further details are provided in the enclosed player eligibility document.

To help clubs meet UEFA medical requirements, national associations should make resources available to their member clubs wherever possible. These may include access to examination and screening facilities at national association training centres, and lending them medical kit such as defibrillators, stretchers and emergency medical bags for matches and when MD-1 training sessions are at the same venue as the match.

In 2019 UEFA launched a concussion awareness campaign to educate players, coaches, referees, doctors and the general public about the dangers of concussion. With this in mind, and as a further step towards protecting the health of players, the UEFA Medical Committee has prepared a Concussion Charter to be signed by a club representative, the head coach and the team doctor of each participating team. A circular letter will be sent out in due course, requesting that the signed charter is sent to medical@uefa.ch. Further information on the process, other medical issues, including medical regulations and minimum medical requirements will be provided in that same circular letter. If there are any medical questions in the meantime, please send them to medical@uefa.ch.

4. Draws

Enclosure 5 Deadlines gives details of all UEFA Futsal Champions League draws: dates, times, venues and competition stages.

- Draw 1, at UEFA on 7 July 2022, will allocate the registered teams to the groups of the preliminary round and main round path A and path B.
- Draw 2, at UEFA on 3 November 2022, will allocate the qualified teams to the groups of the elite round.
- Finally, a third draw will be held in the city hosting the finals in February/March 2023 to determine the order of the semi-finals.
