DEADLINES FOR THE 2022/23 MONITORING PROCESS

As per Articles 75.03 and 78.03 of the CL&FS Regulations, please find below the applicable deadlines for the submission of the following information to the UEFA Administration:

- > Solvency requirements (Overdue Payables) as at 15 July and 15 October 2022 as well as 15 January 2023;
- ▶ **Break-Even requirement** for the current monitoring period assessed in the 2022/23 season, i.e. the reporting periods ending in 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022¹. In line with the UEFA Executive Committee decision, the reporting periods ending in 2020 and 2021 are being considered as one single reporting period; and
- ➤ **Club Information**, which comprises the club's legal group structure and information on its ultimate controlling party, its ultimate beneficiary and any party with significant influence, for the reporting periods ending in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022².

⁵ Pursuant to Article 62 (4) of the *UEFA Club Licensing and Financial Fair Play Regulations – Edition 2018*, the CFCB First Chamber decided, at its last meeting of May 2022, to request all licensees subject to the break-even requirement to submit information for the reporting period ending in 2022 (in line with the new procedure foreseen in the CL&FS Regulations).

15 March 2023 (if applicable)	 → Scope: Clubs admitted to the 2022/23 UEFA competitions which are not exempt from the break-even requirement, and with a reporting period T ending after 31 July 2022. Club Information package including the updated club's information and legal group structure for the reporting period ending in 2022. Financial Information package including the final break-even information for the reporting period ending in 2022 based on audited annual financial statements.
