- Insufficient protection of the playing area against intruders, Art. 40.01 SSR
 - One (1) match behind closed doors subject to probationary period of two (2) years
 - Fine: €80,000

 - Fine: €1,750
- Unsporting conduct (Mr. David Moyes), Article 15(1)(a)(v) DR
 - Suspension: next one (1) UEFA club competition match
- Directing abusive language against a match official (Mr. Declan Rice), Art. 15(1)(b) DR
 - Suspension: next two (2) UEFA club competition matches

 - One (1) match behind closed doors subject to probationary period of two (2) years
 - Fine: €40,000
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 SSR
 - Fine: €20,000
- Use of laser pointer, Art. 16(2)(d) DR
 - Fine: €12,000

Feyenoord

Incidents and decision:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Ban from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match
 - Fine: €30,000
