2021/22 UEFA fair play competition – final rankings

Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to inform you of the final UEFA fair play rankings for 2021/22, which are based on the fair play results obtained from all UEFA competition matches played at both club and national team level between 1 July 2021 and 30 June 2022.

Only associations that played a minimum of 46 matches have been taken into account. This cut-off point was obtained by dividing the total number of UEFA matches by the number of participating UEFA member associations.

As defined in paragraph 12.01 of the UEFA Fair Play Regulations, awards are given to the highest-ranked associations in the following three categories:

- Overall fair play
- Improvement in overall fair play score from one season to the next
- Behaviour of spectators

The winning associations in each of the three categories will be awarded €50,000 each to donate to the amateur or professional club of their choice for a fair play or respect-themed project.

The results are as follows:

- Overall fair play: **Wales** with 8.551 points.
- Improvement in overall fair play score from one season to the next: **Northern Ireland** progressing from 7.695 points in 2020/21 to 8.228 points in 2021/22 (+0.533 points).
 - Wales finished first in this category with a progression of +0.949 points, but as they had already won the award for the best overall fair play rankings, the best progression award goes instead to the second-ranked association, as stipulated in paragraph 13.02 of the UEFA Fair Play Regulations.
- Behaviour of spectators: **Malta** with 9.062 points.

Each of the winning associations is invited to send the name of its selected club, along with details of the project to which the prize money will be allocated, to delegate@uefa.ch. Following an assessment of the proposed projects, the prize money will be credited to the winning associations' accounts.
