Provisional League Formation

For the league stage of the 2023-25 UEFA Nations League phase, the participating teams will be allocated to Leagues A to C based on the *UEFA Women's National Team Coefficient Rankings at the end of the qualifying group stage of the 2021-23 UEFA European Qualifying Competition for the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup.

Following is the provisional league formation, comprising the associations that participated in the 2021-23 competition, as per these rankings.
