5th UEFA Football Law Programme (UEFA FLP) – Applications now open

Dear Sir or Madam,

The UEFA Football Law Programme (UEFA FLP) is designed specifically for legal specialists in UEFA's member associations, which face constantly evolving legal challenges. Given the inherent complexity of these issues, the programme also encourages cooperation between various stakeholders, so that members of the football community are better equipped to take on future challenges in this rapidly evolving field.

While enabling participants to continue to develop professionally, the UEFA FLP also serves as academic recognition for their work. The programme comprises four intensive week-long sessions over a period of 12 months. All four sessions must be attended in full, so participants need to be released by their organisations. While demanding, the course can still be combined with normal professional activities, and the knowledge, experience and networks gained will, of course, also benefit the associations.

The fifth UEFA FLP maintains the high educational standards and success of the previous four editions, and builds on experience while introducing new ideas and topics through new partnerships.

The UEFA FLP is designed for people who have not previously attended any football law programme. Primarily open to national associations' legal counsel, the programme is also addressed to employees of clubs, leagues, players' unions and law firms. All participants should have at least two years' experience in law and have a good command of spoken and written English.

In the case of national association staff, the president or general secretary must sign the application form, and each association may put only one applicant forward. UEFA will cover all their course fees together with flights, accommodation, lunches and coffee breaks. Evening dinners and other expenses, such as local transport, must be covered by the participants themselves.
