Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the above-mentioned regulations were approved by the UEFA Executive Committee on 28 June 2023 and are now available in the [UEFA Documents portal](#).

### **Key amendments**

#### All four sets of regulations

##### *Responsibilities of the associations*

- Like all the other UEFA competitions, a new paragraph on Football Social Responsibility has been added to raise the awareness of the participating teams on this topic.

##### *Match and mini-tournament preparation*

- This new paragraph emphasises the fact that teams must use the TIME platform to communicate with their opponents.

##### *Rules governing the technical area*

- This paragraph has been updated to allow up to five substitute players to warm up at the same time if the space permits it.

##### *Protests and appeals*

- Updated to include the proof of payment of the protest fee when a protest is lodged.

##### *Colours*

- This paragraph has been updated to take into account the new online tool that the teams have to use to submit their playing attire colours to be worn for each match and who is validating the colours whether it is the qualifying phase or final tournament.

*Accreditations and access rights*

- The team dressing rooms are off limits to media representatives but subject to the teams' prior agreement, one camera crew of the host broadcaster may enter the dressing room. The article details that UEFA's involvement is limited to the final tournament only and for the qualifying competition, the concerned team alone may agree to this approach.

*Mixed zone*

- Instead of all players, a minimum of three players who have participated in the match must conduct interviews in the mixed zone.

Under-17 competition only

*Competition system, qualifying competition*

- The format of the qualifying phase has been adapted to the participation of 54 associations. As a consequence, only one team is seeded for the elite round and the five best third-placed teams in the qualifying round progress to the elite round.
