The categorisation of UEFA member associations for all UEFA competitions for the **2023/24 season** is based on the figures available on 7 July 2023 for GNI per capita (following the "Atlas methodology") developed by the World Bank and indicated below. The GNI per capita thresholds which UEFA has defined for each category of UEFA member associations are USD 13,000 (Category 2) and USD 37,000 (Category 3).
