

The UEFA Youth League play-off draw will be streamed live at 12:00 CET on Tuesday 19 December, setting ties to be played on 6 and 7 February.

### **Draw conditions**

The draw respects the following principles, in accordance with Paragraph 16.02 of the 2023/24 UEFA Youth League regulations:

The eight winners of the second round of the domestic champions path will be drawn against the eight group runners-up of the UEFA Champions League path group stage.

Clubs from the same association cannot be drawn against each other.

The eight winners of the second round of the domestic champions path play at home (single-leg ties).

### **Draw procedure**

Eight balls containing the names of the winners of the second round of the domestic champions path are placed in a bowl.

A first ball is drawn from the bowl. The team drawn is placed as the home team in match 1.

In accordance with the above draw conditions, the computer then shows which runners-up from the UEFA Champions League path group stage are eligible to play as the visiting team in match 1. These teams' names are placed in a bowl.

A ball is drawn from that bowl to complete the pairing for match 1 with the team drawn placed as the visiting team in this match.

The above procedure is repeated for the remaining matches.

If the computer indicates that only one runner-up from the UEFA Champions League path group stage is eligible to play as the visiting team in a match, that team is automatically assigned to the match and no ball is drawn.
