

# Stadium Rules for the 2024 UEFA SUPER CUP™

## 1 Scope

These Stadium Rules (hereinafter “Rules”) together with the relevant local laws and any policies or procedures put in place in respect of sanitary measures shall apply to all persons who enter the stadium premises used in connection with the ongoing mass event according to the law of Poland, namely the UEFA Super Cup™ 2024 (hereinafter "Match"). Stadium premises shall include all venue areas, including all entrances and exits, as well as all other official areas and facilities (hereinafter "Stadium") that are accessible with an Accreditation, Match ticket or other admission document determined by UEFA and/or the Organiser (the Organiser being the Polish Football Association).

## 2 Entrance

2.1 Persons may only enter the Stadium with an Accreditation or Match ticket acquired and used in compliance with the accreditation terms and conditions and ticketing terms and conditions (as applicable), Match tickets acquired or used in breach of ticketing terms and conditions shall be void and any person seeking to use such Match ticket will be refused entry or will be deemed a trespasser and be evicted from the Stadium, and may be liable to further legal action.

2.2 Entrance to the Stadium shall only be authorised upon presentation of an Accreditation or valid Match ticket per person (regardless of age) and, upon request, proof of identity (such as ID, passport). The Match ticket as well as proof of identity must be shown and handed over for inspection on entry and inside the Stadium at the request of any steward, safety personnel and/or any other legally authorised persons representing the Organiser or UEFA. Failure to comply shall result in access to the Stadium being denied or expulsion from the Stadium.

2.3 Minors under the age of 16 shall only be authorised to enter the Stadium with an accompanying adult, who will be responsible for them. The accompanying adult shall also hold a valid ticket.

2.4 Driving and parking of vehicles inside the Stadium and/or within the Stadium perimeter shall only be permitted with the special authorisation of Organiser and/or UEFA.

2.5 The validity and usability of Match tickets shall be determined according to the relevant ticketing terms and conditions.

2.6 There is no re-admission to the Stadium.

### **3 Personal controls**

3.1 Stewards or police are entitled to examine – including through the use of technical aids – whether persons represent a security risk, in particular whether they have consumed alcohol or drugs or are in possession of weapons or other prohibited items. Stewards or police are entitled to search any person's clothing and other items in their possession.

3.2 Persons who make an unauthorised use of an Accreditation or Match ticket, who do not follow the instructions of Organiser and/or UEFA (or any official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA) or any steward or police officer at the Stadium, or who represent a security risk or who are subject to a local, national or foreign Stadium ban shall be denied access to the Stadium and shall immediately return their Match ticket to UEFA or the Organiser (as instructed), all without refund.

### **4 Conduct inside the Stadium**

4.1 All persons entering the Stadium shall:

(a) conduct themselves in such a way that they do not harm, injure, endanger or unnecessarily obstruct or annoy others, nor cause damage to anything;

(b) follow the instructions of Organiser and/or UEFA (or any official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA) or any steward or police officer present at the Stadium;

(c) occupy the seat allocated to them as described on their Match ticket and use the appropriate access routes. If any person becomes aware of any damage caused to any property or any accident of any kind such person should take immediate steps to inform Organiser and/or UEFA (or any official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA) or any steward or police officer at the Stadium.

4.2 Further exceptional demands may be made in order to prevent, reduce or eliminate danger to life, health or property. Instructions issued by stewards or police must be followed and failure to cooperate may result in expulsion from the Stadium.

## 5 Sound and image recordings and transmissions

5.1. All persons attending the UEFA Super Cup™ 2024 take note that their voice, image and likeness recorded during their time in the Stadium (“Recordings”) may be used, free of charge, in any image, sound and audiovisual material in connection with the UEFA Super Cup™ 2024, either simultaneously or at a later date. UEFA and the Organiser or third parties engaged or otherwise authorised by them in each case (e.g., broadcasting, press) create Recordings for the purpose and on the basis of their legitimate interest of public reporting and promotion of the UEFA Super Cup™ 2024 pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 (1) lit. f of the GDPR. Recordings may be processed, exploited and publicly reproduced by UEFA and the Organiser as well as third parties authorised by them in each case (e.g. broadcasting, press) within the scope of the same legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 (1) lit. f of the GDPR.

5.2. Persons attending the UEFA Super Cup™ 2024 shall not collect, record, use or disseminate any sound, image, recording or depiction of the Stadium or the Match (including any results, statistics, information or other data about the match, in whole or in part) over the internet, radio, television or any other current or future media – or assist any other persons in doing so – unless it is solely for a ticket holder’s non-commercial use for the purposes of recording and/or communicating the fact of their attendance at the Match. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all persons must not: undertake any streaming (via any and all media or technological methods) of the Match (in whole or part), irrespective of whether it is for commercial or non-commercial purposes. For the avoidance of doubt, UEFA or other authorised third parties are entitled to delete, or cause to be deleted, any images transmitted or publicly displayed in breach of this provision, and to bring any other claim against the responsible person (collecting, recording or disseminating as described above) in a judicial or extrajudicial proceeding. In addition, by disseminating any sound, image, recording or depiction in breach of the preceding provisions of this Article, all persons shall grant UEFA the irrevocable right to use, reproduce and commercially exploit such disseminations including the intellectual property rights, if any, in such disseminations. All persons further agree (if and whenever required to do so by UEFA) to promptly execute all instruments and do all things necessary to vest the right, title and interest in such rights to UEFA absolutely and free of all encumbrances and other charges.

5.3. To ensure the safety of the public, the Stadium may be equipped with a video surveillance system controlled by the Stadium, Organiser, police officers or private security officers, images from which are likely to be used in the event of legal proceedings. A right of access is provided for in compliance with local law.

## **6 Prohibited items and conduct**

6.1 The following items may not be brought into the Stadium:

- (a) weapons or explosives of any kind, including anything that could be adapted for use as a weapon or to cut, thrust or stab with, or as a projectile. This includes any fireworks, flares, smoke powder, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnics;
- (b) bottles, cups, jugs or cans of any kind as well as other objects made from PET, glass or any other fragile, non-shatterproof or especially tough material, except items required on duly evidenced medical grounds;
- (c) alcoholic beverages of any kind, drugs, stimulants or psychotropic substances, except items required on duly evidenced medical grounds;
- (d) racist, xenophobic, vulgar, provocative, religious, sexist or political propaganda objects or materials;
- (e) any promotional or commercial objects or materials;
- (f) flagpoles or banner poles of any kind. Only flexible plastic poles and so-called double-poles that do not exceed 1 metre in length and 1 cm in diameter are permitted;
- (g) gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable substances, dyes or receptacles containing substances which are harmful to health or are highly flammable.;
- (h) professional cameras, video cameras or other similar devices;
- (i) unwieldy objects such as helmets, ladders, stools, (folding) chairs, strollers, boxes, large bags, rucksacks, suitcases and sports bags. For the purposes of this rule, “unwieldy” means any objects which are larger than A4 size (210 mm x 297 mm x 210 mm) and which cannot be stowed under the seat in the Stadium;
- (j) large quantities of paper and/or rolls of paper, streamers, confetti;
- (k) mechanically or manually operated sound-emitting devices such as mega-phones, klaxons, vuvuzelas, air-horns, trumpets;
- (l) laser pointers;
- (m) sport balls, beach balls, balloons;

(n) drones and other items that may disrupt the Match.

The above list is not exhaustive. In case of any doubt with regards to any object being brought to the Stadium, the relevant steward or official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA shall be responsible for defining which objects are prohibited or permitted.

6.2 Unless expressly authorised by Organiser and/or UEFA the following items may not be brought into the Stadium:

(a) animals (except assistance dogs);

(b) banners or flags larger than 2.0 x 1.5 metres. Smaller flags and banners are permitted provided that they are made from material which is deemed “non-flammable” and comply with national regulations and standards. The above list is not exhaustive. In case of any doubt with regards to any object being brought to the Stadium, the relevant steward or official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA shall be responsible for defining which objects are prohibited or permitted.

6.3 It is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium, without limitation:

(a) throw objects or liquids of any kind, particularly in the direction of another person or in the direction of the area around the pitch or the pitch itself;

(b) start a fire, let off or launch fireworks, flares, or other pyrotechnics;

(c) express or disseminate political, religious, racist, xenophobic, vulgar propaganda and pursuits or slogans and emblems;

(d) act in a way which may be interpreted by others as provocative, threatening, discriminatory or offensive;

(e) sell goods and tickets, distribute printed material and hold collections or carry out other promotional or commercial activities without prior written authorisation from Organiser and/or UEFA (or any official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA);

(f) enter the pitch or the area around the pitch;

(g) climb on or over structures and installations not expressly intended for that use;

(h) write or paint on or affix anything to structural elements, installations or pathways;

(i) relieve oneself anywhere other than in the toilets, or litter the Stadium by discarding objects such as rubbish, packaging, empty containers, etc;

(j) stand on seats in the spectator areas;

(k) any other conduct which is prohibited or is dangerous or threatening.

6.3a Smoking is strictly prohibited in all areas of the Stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes and heat not burn tobacco products is also forbidden.

6.4 A portable mobile phone charging device which is similar size to or smaller than the phone itself will be permitted inside the Stadium.

6.5 Unless otherwise authorised to do so by Organiser and/or UEFA (or any official appointed by Organiser and/or UEFA), it is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium, without limitation:

- (a) access areas (e.g. function rooms, VIP and media areas, etc.), which are closed to the public or for which access is unauthorised;
- (b) restrict or loiter in areas open to traffic, footpaths and roadways, entrances and exits to visitor areas and emergency exits;
- (c) any other conduct which is not authorised.

6.6 Any breach of the Rules may result in the following penalties being imposed:

- (a) expulsion from the Stadium and possible handing over to the police;
- (b) cancellation and invalidation of the Match ticket and banning of the offender from all next matches organised by Organiser;
- (c) provision, in accordance with applicable laws, of the relevant personal information to respective national football associations and/or the police so that appropriate measures can be taken, e.g. national stadium bans;
- (d) initiating by Organiser and/or UEFA or any other authorised persons or entities of legal proceedings;
- (e) any other penalties or remedies in accordance with applicable laws.

Organiser and/or UEFA reserve all other rights to pursue other legal remedies at their own discretion.

6.7 UEFA and the Organiser reserve the right to make alterations to the time, date and location of the Match due to unforeseen extraordinary circumstances: force majeure, safety and/or security reasons or other decisions made by any competent authority which have a major impact on the Match being played at the Stadium.

## **7 Liability**

7.1 Any person attending a Match acknowledges that they do so at their own risk and that they may be liable for damage or loss resulting from any of their acts at the Stadium.

## **8 Severability and amendments**

8.1 Should any provision of the Rules be declared void, ineffective or unenforceable by any competent court, the remainder of the Rules shall remain in effect as if such void, ineffective or unenforceable provision had not been contained.

8.2 Organiser and UEFA reserve the right to make reasonable amendments to the Rules from time to time, the latest and effective version of which shall be available on [www.pzpn.pl](http://www.pzpn.pl) and at the Stadium.

8.3 During the Match, these Rules shall take precedence over the internal rules of the Stadium.

## **9 Authentic text**

9.1 The Rules have been drafted in Polish and translated into English. In the event of any discrepancy between the texts, the Polish text shall prevail.

## **10 Applicable law and jurisdiction**

10.1 The Rules shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Poland.

10.2 All disputes arising from or related to the Rules shall be submitted to the competent court in Warsaw.

Materiały pirotechniczne / pyrotechnics



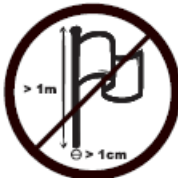
Napoje alkoholowe, narkotyki, substancje pobudzające, psychotropowe / alcohol drinks, drugs, stimulants or psychotropic substances
