European Women's Championship 2025

Lithuanian Football Federation

Lithuania vs. Belarus, 31.05.2024 Belarus vs. Lithuania; 04.06.2024

Incident and decision:

- Refusal to play, Art. 38.01 Regulations of the UEFA European Women's Championship including UEFA Nations League and European Qualifiers in conjunction with Art. 27(1) DR
 - To declare the 2025 European Women's Championship 2025 match between the representative Women teams of the Lithuanian Football Federation and the Belarusian Football Federation, that was scheduled to be played on 31 May 2024, as forfeited by the Lithuanian Football Federation (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 0-3) for being responsible for the match not taking place.
 - To declare the 2025 European Women's Championship 2025 match between the representative Women teams of the Belarusian Football Federation and the Lithuanian Football Federation, that was scheduled to be played on 4 June 2024, as forfeited by the Lithuanian Football Federation (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 3-0) for being responsible for the match not taking place.
 - Fine: €5,000

 - Serious rough play (Mr. Kristijan Postružin), Art. 15(1)(d) DR
 - > Suspension: two (2) UEFA representative team competition matches
- Improper conduct of the team, Art. 15(4) DR
 - Fine: €1,800
