

# HOUSE RULES

Please respect the following rules and instructions that have been for event safety to avoid risk to persons or damage to items and to ensure that the UEFA EURO 2024™ is enjoyable and trouble-free.



## 1. The area of application

## 2. House rules

When entering the fenced-in area, the following rules and the following rules and instructions are acknowledged:

- 2.1 For the aforementioned areas there is a maximum capacity of authorised persons. If these this capacity has been exhausted, no further persons will no longer be permitted to enter. There is no right to re-admission.
- 2.2 The entire aforementioned areas are under video surveillance. Furthermore, film recordings may be made.
- 2.3 All persons entering the event site must behave in such a way that no others are harmed, endangered, or harassed. Violations can lead to a ban. If a person commits criminal offences (e.g. drug dealing, assault, theft sexual assault, etc.), this person will be banned from the event immediately and without warning. All criminal offences will be reported immediately. Anyone who culpably violates these house rules, is liable to the the organiser for the damages incurred.
- 2.4 The organiser's house rules are exercised by the organiser and the event security service. All persons entering, the event site must comply with the instructions of the event security service. Anyone who does not follow these orders may be trespassed from the event grounds for one or more days.
- 2.5 Admission controls will be carried out in the form of bag and identity checks. Prohibited objects include, among others:
  - (a) firearms, knives of any kind, as well as items for slashing, stabbing and other weapons of all kinds
  - (b) saws, axes, hatchets, and dangerous tools or objects of any kind
  - (c) Highly flammable cans such as deodorant, hairspray and animal repellent spray
  - (d) Bulky objects (e.g. umbrellas and chairs of any kind) chairs of any kind)
  - (e) Fireworks, sparklers and and other pyrotechnic items
  - (f) Backpacks, bags and the like larger than DIN A4
  - (g) Flag or banner poles that are longer than 1.0 m and/or whose diameter is is more than 10 mm
  - (h) Any glasses, glass, and PET bottles
  - (i) Cups (with the exception of Host City Cologne refundable cups) made of a fragile or splintering material or larger than 0.5 litres, as well as all beverage cans

- (j) Mechanically and electrically operated instruments and musical instruments
- (k) Intoxicants such as alcohol, medicines with mood-altering substances and drugs
- (l) Animals, excluding assistance dogs
- (m) discriminatory, racist, xenophobic, violence-inciting, hostile, radical political, national socialist or religious propaganda material and equivalent objects of all kinds (e.g. items of clothing, signs, banners, etc.)

Carrying the above-mentioned or comparable items may result in the visitor being trespassed from the event.

- 2.6 It is prohibited to possess cannabis.
- 2.7 All emergency and evacuation routes must be kept clear at all times.
- 2.8 Racist, sexist, homophobic and other statements will not be tolerated. In fact, all guests are urged to point out undesirable guests directly to the event security service.
- 2.9 Entering the cordoned-off areas and climbing objects of any kind is prohibited.
- 2.10 Structural installations, facilities or paths may not be not be damaged, labelled, painted, pasted on, or altered in any other way.
- 2.11 Persons who are visibly under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be denied access.
- 2.12 It is prohibited to urinate outside the toilets urinate or defecate outside the designated sanitary facilities.
- 2.13 The general rules of the Youth Protection Act apply.
- 2.14 It is prohibited to enter the area on bicycles, Segways e-scooters, skateboards, etc.
- 2.15 It is prohibited to vend or proffer unauthorised goods, distribute printed matter and other items of all kinds or to organise collections.
- 2.16 Flying and carrying drones above and on the event area is prohibited.
- 2.17 Every person who enters the event area agrees to only make audio and/or video recordings of the event for private use and/or to transmit them privately. In doing so the personal rights of other guests must be respected at all times.

Should any provision of this contract be invalid the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby.
