Incidents and sanction:

- Racist and/or discriminatory behaviour, Art. 14(2) DR
 - Fine: €15,000
 - Partial stadium closure for the next one (1) UEFA club competition it will play has host club. Said partial stadium closure is suspended during a probationary period of two (2) years
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 UEFA Safety and Security Regulations
 - Fine: €6,000

Fenerbahçe SK

Incidents and sanction:

- Racist and/or discriminatory behaviour, Art. 14(2) DR
 - Fine: €15,000
 - Ban from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next one (1) UEFA club competition. Said ban from selling tickets to its away supporters is suspended during a probationary period of two (2) years
- Improper conduct of the team, Art. 15(4) DR
 - Fine: €8,000
- Acts of damage caused to the stadium and/or its installations, Art. 16(2)(f) DR
 - Fine: €15,500
 - Contact FC Viktoria Plzeň for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
 - Fine: €25,000
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €15,000

 - Fine: €12,000
- Unsporting conduct (Mr. Vasileios Barkas), Art. 15(1)(a)(v) DR
 - Suspension: one (1) UEFA club competition match

FC Porto

Incidents and sanction:

- Improper conduct of the team, Art. 15(4) DR
 - Fine: €7,000
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €9,500
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
 - Fine: €15,000

NK Celje vs. Legia Warszawa (2:1); 6 November 2025

NK Celje

Incident and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €30,000
 - Partial stadium closure for the next one (1) UEFA club competition it will play as host club. Said partial stadium closure is suspended during a probationary period of two (2) years

Legia Warszawa

Incident and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Order the enforcement of the suspended disciplinary measure imposed by the Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body in its decision of 15 January 2025, i.e. to ban Legia Warszawa from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match
 - Fine: €20,000
 - Ban from selling tickets to its away supporters for the one (1) additional UEFA club competition. Said ban from selling tickets to its away supporters is suspended during a probationary period of two (2) years
