 - Fine: €15,500
- Late kick-off, Art. 11(2)(h) DR
 - Fine: €15,000

 - Warning

Incidents and sanction:

- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 UEFA Safety and Security Regulations
 - Fine: €24,000
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
 - Fine: €12,375
- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
 - Fine: €20,000

Olympique de Marseille

Incidents and sanction:

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Order the enforcement of the suspended disciplinary measure imposed by the Control, Ethics and Disciplinary Body in its decision of 28 February 2024, i.e. to ban Olympique de Marseille from selling tickets to its away-supporters for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match
 - Fine: €25,000
 - Ban from selling tickets to its away supporters for one (1) additional UEFA club competition match. Said ban from selling tickets to its away supporters is suspended for a probationary period of two (2) years

 - Warning
- Insufficient limitation of spectator movement, Art. 37.01 UEFA Safety and Security Regulations
 - Fine: €5,000

- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
- Bringing the sport of football, and UEFA in particular, into disrepute, Art. 11(2)(d) DR
 - Fine: €50,000

Go Ahead Eagles

Incidents and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €30,000
 - Partial stadium closure during the next one (1) UEFA club competition match it will play as host club. Said partial stadium closure is suspended for a probationary period of two (2) years
- Matchday media activities, Art. 79.01(e) Regulations of the UEFA Europa League
 - Warning

SC Braga

Incident and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €3,000
