  - Partial stadium closure for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match it will play as host club. Said partial stadium closure is suspended for a probationary period of one (1) year.
- Unsporting conduct (Mr. Pedro Luís Ferreira Machado), Art. 15(1)(a)(v) DR
  - Suspension: one (1) UEFA club competition match
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
  - Fine: €25,000
- Use of laser pointer, Art. 16(2)(d) DR
  - Fine: €8,000

### GNK Dinamo

Incidents and sanction:

- Assaulting another player (Mr. Luka Stojković), Art. 15(1)(e) DR
  - Suspension: three (3) UEFA club competition matches
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
  - Fine: €51,750
- Acts of damage caused to the stadium and/or its installations, Art. 16(2)(f) DR
  - Fine: €5,000
  - Contact KRC Genk for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters

Incident and sanction:

- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
  - Fine: €5,000

- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
  - Fine: €30,000
  - Ban from selling tickets to its away supporters for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match.
- Acts of damage caused to the stadium and/or its installations, Art. 16(2)(f) DR
  - Fine: €20,500
  - Contact Nottingham Forest FC for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters

Incidents and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
  - Fine: €17,000
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
  - Fine: €10,500
- Blocking of public passageways, Art. 38 UEFA Safety and Security Regulations
  - Fine: €28,000
- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
- Bringing the sport of football, and UEFA in particular, into disrepute, Art. 11(2)(d) DR
  - Fine: €40,000

  - Fine: €12,750
- Late kick-off, Art. 11(2)(h) DR
  - Fine: 30,000

  - Fine: €26,000

  - Fine: €4,250
- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
  - Fine: €17,500
