 - Warning
- Throwing of objects, Art. 16(2)(b) DR
 - Fine: €16,875
- Acts of damage caused to the stadium and/or its installations, Art. 16(2)(f) DR
 - Fine: €8,000
 - Contact Racing Club de Strasbourg Alsace for the settlement of the damages caused by its supporters
- Crowd disturbances, Art. 16(2)(h) DR
 - Fine: €10,000

FC Shakhtar Donetsk vs. Crystal Palace F.C. (1:3); 30 April 2026**FC Shakhtar Donetsk**

Incidents and sanction:

- Racist and/or discriminatory behaviour, Art. 14 DR
 - Fine: €30,000
 - Partial stadium closure for the next one (1) UEFA club competition match it plays as host club. Said partial stadium closure is suspended for a probationary period of two (2) years
- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €4,000

Crystal Palace F.C.

Incidents and sanction:

- Lighting of fireworks, Art. 16(2)(c) DR
 - Fine: €3,000
- Transmitting a message that is not fit for a sports event, Art. 16(2)(e) DR
 - Fine: €25,000

European Under-19 Championship 2027

[Latvia vs. Belarus; 15 May 2026](#)

Incident and sanction:

- Refusal to play, Art. 28.01 Regulations of the UEFA European Under-19 Championship in conjunction with Art. 27 UEFA DR
 - To declare the match as forfeited by the Latvian Football Federation (who is therefore deemed to have lost the match 3-0) for being responsible for the match not taking place.
